Logan Elementary School PTSO

Report and Recommendations from the 2022-23 Goals Meeting

Purpose: To determine and set priorities for both short and long-term goals to provide for continued development, growth and improvement of Logan Elementary PTSO. The agreed upon goals are submitted to the Logan PTSO for review and incorporation into the planning process for the 2022-23 school year.

Key Goals and Continual Improvement Recommendations:

- 1. Direct efforts towards building a strong and supportive community across Logan. Focus efforts towards community building that creates a sense of unity across Logan that benefits students, teachers and families. Directed activities may include parents night out, community service opportunities, room parent communication and in-person celebrations when appropriate. Consider the creation of a 'community building coordinator' as a PTSO role.
- 2. Plan for hybrid (in-person and virtual) PTSO meetings. Continue to provide a virtual option (i.e. Zoom) for meetings held in person. Alternate meeting times (i.e. mostly AM and with two PM meetings per year) to ensure all Logan families have the opportunity to attend.
- 3. Act as a support to teachers and students and continue incorporating flexibility into the budget to support unexpected events.
- 4. Continue to utilize a budget that accurately reflects the needs and wants of the school.
- 5. Continue to utilize a comprehensive plan for fundraising while considering the changing needs of the PTSO.
- 6. Determine a yearly primary goal for specific fundraising, such as the outdoor space improvement from 2021-22. Survey the Logan community in Spring or early Fall 2022 to identify key fundraising ideas and themes.
- 7. Continue with the successful welcome activities, i.e. New Family Tour, Kindergarten Playdate and Welcome Event, with dates communicated early. Plan for in-person events, but consider virtual options as needed.
- 8. Continue to utilize the Logan PTSO website with timely updates, social media consistency among platforms and link to Logan PTSO calendar.
- 9. Continued support of classroom teachers through the teacher vouchers and mini-grants.
- 10. Continued support and coordination of the enrichment programs including bringing groups to Logan, offering virtual events and as well as helping to fund field trips. Ensure enrichment programs provide a variety of experiences. Align funding for field trip transportation based on 2019-2020 spend.

- 11. Maintain ability to respond and support requests that come through each year (i.e. Staff Lounge update, etc.). The request for donations toward specific goals should continue at the time of regular dues.
- 12. PTSO will provide support to purchase books and literature for the classrooms and library.

These goals and recommendations are submitted to the Logan PTSO for review and incorporation into the planning process for the 2022-23 school year.
