Guest Speaker - Jody Dungey - Day of Awesomeness

- Jody Dungey is our guest speaker tonight from the Power of Purpose family that hosts the Day of Awesomeness. He spoke to the PTSO previously about the Day of Awesomeness just before the pandemic began.
- The goal of this event is:
 - Fantastic student experience
 - Ease for parents and guardians
 - Ease for school and staff
 - Make the needed money for the school without the challenges of traditional fundraising
- Before the actual Day of Awesomeness Event, Jody will host a kickoff assembly as "Joe Cool." There are virtual kickoff options if we'd prefer to not do it in person. At the end of the assembly, students will get an information packet to take home.
- Parents and guardians can set up an online student donation page. Students will
 then send emails to their loved ones asking for donations they are encouraged to
 send at least 10 messages. This email can give more information about what we
 are raising money for at Scarlett. The fundraising website can also be shared on
 social media. Donors can send messages of encouragement to the student.
 Scarlett PTSO will have access to the back end of the fundraising page.
- Students will also receive a traditional pledge sheet for those who would prefer not to donate online.
- There are prize sheets in the packet. Prizes are based both on numbers of emails sent and/or amount of money raised.
- There are 3 programs available so that we can adjust the event based on Covid restrictions.
- 80% of the money raised goes back to the school.

- The PTSO would help distribute materials and 10-12 volunteers would be needed on the day of the event. There are inflatable activities, games, etc. at the actual event.
- The planned date for the event is April 20th.
