- **Approve October meeting minutes:** Mr. Vazquez motioned to approve October's meeting minutes, John Franks seconded, and all approved.

Principal's Report - Mr. Vazquez and Dr. Peterson

- First Quarter is over. Schoology is a one stop shop to see grades and assignments. Mr. V sent another message to parents encouraging them to make a parent Schoology account. Teachers have until Wednesday to submit final grades, and by Friday, parents can also see grades on Powerschool.
- Students finished NWEA testing. 98% of the Scarlett student body successfully tested.
- Dr. Peterson said that we have the go ahead to start virtual clubs. Parents have volunteered to lead some of the clubs. Contact Dr. Peterson with any questions.

President's Report – Nicky Geyer

- Nicky is working on the Spirit Wear inventory and would like to update the website so that families can order online.
- This is the time of year that we usually start planning for the yearly Carnival. We usually ask for donations for the auction at this time, but Nicky suggested that we not attempt to prepare for the carnival as we usually do and made a motion to delay planning. Mr. Vazquez seconded. All approved.
- Holiday Giving:
 - The district is planning to give families in need gift cards to cover holiday food expenses.

- Nicky is going to look into the previous Disney tickets from the Carnival. We need

to auction them before they expire. We can also add other items donated to last year's canceled carnival.

Treasurer's Report - Mimoza Ramaxhiku

• The October income was \$1,010.38 and we spent around \$780.89. The checking account balance is \$10,706.00 and the saving's account balance is \$23,062.

PTOC Update - Jill Pritts

• The next PTOC meeting is Monday, November 16th from 7 to 8:30 pm. The district PTOs and participants will be discussing challenges with online learning - what's working and what's not.

Restaurant Nights - Heather Finnie

- Our restaurant night at Wicked Mary's brought in \$400.00. It was so popular that they ran out of chicken.
- Olga's on Washtenaw is set up for November 13th. Heather is also setting up a Restaurant Night with Curry On on Plymouth Rd. who will donate 25% of sales to Scarlett.
- Heather is still looking for suggestions for other Scarlett family owned businesses or local businesses to host restaurant nights.

Open Discussion

Beth noted that there is uneven participation regarding camera use at school. Is
