- Discussion re: solutions for gaps in math literacy Dan Neaton, former AAPS math teacher and parent, https://www.mynumberdna.com/
  - o Taught at Claugue for 7 years. Has spent retirement partnered with another math educator to develop a program to help fill in gaps and raise score levels. Shared data from different interventions at schools. Concerned about Scarlett's MSTEP scores out of step with the district. Designed to make fast progress and build fast facts math fluency. Shared thoughts on Dreambox, which district has heavily invested in.
  - o Dr P shared that after many years of asking the district for more support there is now 1.5 FTE for Math support as well as afternoon tutoring. Admin will connect with Dan.

  - o Spiritwear Question about availability from Kinda. Also, 6th grade shirts, not yet received? Need clarification. Adelaide shared what system are in place now and what is possible with more support and volunteer power. We'd love help on this!
