## Treasurer's Report & Budgeting - Nicky Geyer

- Carnival expenses were a little higher this year than last year.
- Discussed idea for next year to auction student artwork at the Carnival.
- The PTSO increased the available Teacher Grant money to \$10.000. The office will differentiate whether the money will come from the school or the PTSO.
- PLTW requested a ShopVac and the PTSO donated \$80.
- The Sign Language group can sign the National Anthem at a Tiger's game on the 18th, but funding for transportation is in the works. Some students are also coming from Pioneer.
- PLTW might take 8th grade students to visit the PLTW class at Huron High School. 8th Grade is also planning a trip to the Henry Ford museum.
- There has been a request to fix microscopes, so the PTSO is looking into the cost of purchasing new ones, and wondering if that is a school expense or a PTSO expense.
- Including the benefits of PTSO fundraising in the next Monday message a list of where the funds have been used.
- Restaurant night income was low this year.
- Leo's fundraising night will be in early May.
- Last year's trip to Rolling Hills fell onto this year's budget.
- Discussed a donation mailer campaign for the end of the year to help boost funds over the summer.
