- Vicki mentioned a baker from Mitchell Elementary that might be able to provide allergy friendly baked goods for the Cake Walk.

Open Discussion

- Mr. Wills-Begley came to discuss the Chicago trip which is in the planning stages. In the
 past, the PTO has paid for 8th grade trip tshirts, bus driver and tour guide tips, and one

 assistance. The PTSO has helped with scholarships in the past.
