- **Approve December meeting minutes:** Mr. Vazquez motioned to approve December's meeting minutes, Jill seconded, and all approved.

#### Principal's Report - Mr. Vazquez and Dr. Peterson

- The Governor is strongly encouraging school districts to offer some in person learning by March.
  - Mr. V does not yet have any news on this from the district regarding this.
  - Moving forward, schools will probably focus on most at risk populations first.
  - Mr. V wants to be hopeful that hybrid can happen now that the vaccine is being distributed, but he doesn't know any specifics. If hybrid happens, it will likely still be a virtual type setting - students at home can interact with students at school. He will know more after his principal's meeting with Dr. Swift.
- A communication was sent out to families about the incident at the Capital. Mr. V and Dr. Peterson are proud of the teacher's response to this. Students will eventually be the leaders, and it's important to seize teachable moments to encourage parents and students to learn from these events.
- The semester ends in a couple of weeks. Students taking classes for high school credit will be taking exams.
- Semester 2 will begin the 1st week of February. This Wednesday in Professional Development with the teachers, they will transition to Power Teacher Pro. Schoology info will sync with this program. Schoology is helpful, but Powerschool is still needed for some things.

### President's Report – Nicky Geyer

- Scarlett families were proud that Mr. Vazquez and Dr. Peterson stepped up and made a statement about the event at the Capital.
- Nicky thanked those who donated to the Holiday Giving fund. Mr. V noted that we still have some gift cards and would like to give those to Scarlett families in need.
- Teachers were very thankful for their holiday gift cards. Thank you to Mimoza for making this happen.

# Treasurer's Report - Mimoza Ramaxhiku and John Franks

- The December monthly summary is as follows:
  - There were some expenses for Zoom and the Amazon gift cards.
  - The ending Savings Balance was \$10,776.88.
  - The Ending Checking Balance was \$25,386.97.
  - The CD Balance was \$6, 047.16.
