Open Positions:

- Co-Treasurer (1 opening) Serve as custodians of the PTO's finances, collect revenue, pay authorized expenses, follow all financial policies of the PTO, and hold all financial records.
- PTOC Representative (1 opening) Attend and represent the Thurston PTO at the AAPS PTO Council (PTOC) meetings. Obtain options or recommendations from the PTOC to open items facing the Thurston PTO. Report back to the Thurston PTO as to new information from the PTOC.

Health, Safety and Wellness Officer - Gina Schneider


