
The 2023 PTO Election ballot is now available! Please take a moment to submit your vote. The deadline is midnight on Friday June 2nd.

Congratulations Thurston Math Club!

Congratulations to all who participated in our brand new Thurston Math Club this year! Students came together each week to explore a variety of math questions and puzzles, to collaboratively develop their problem-solving skills and to prepare for the international Math Kangaroo competition this spring.



In the USA, more than 30,000 kids in grades 1-12 took the Math Kangaroo test this year. 4,872 of these students ranked top-20 in the country and 1,830 students ranked top-3 at the state level. **Four of our Thurston Math Club members were recognized in these rankings!**
