

Interested 3rd - 5th graders can now join this year's Academic Games Team. Logan and Thurston Elementary Schools come together every year to form a team and compete against other schools from across the state. Come and play a series of games designed to develop, challenge, and test knowledge in several different subject areas beyond what is taught in school. Students compete in games that cover Math, English, Social Studies and Logic. The primary purpose of Academic Games is to make learning fun for students.

Practice times for the 2023 - 2024 school year are still being determined, but they are typically Tuesdays and Thursdays. Academic Games team members are encouraged to attend a minimum of one practice a week, but are welcome to attend as often as they wish. Competitions occur about once a month on Saturdays. #### Help us plan the Enchanted Nature Walk!



#### **My Future Fund**



Ann Arbor Public Schools is excited to announce a new partnership with My Future Fund, operated by the Washtenaw Intermediate School District in collaboration with the Washtenaw County Government. My Future Fund is an opportunity for all 2nd-6th grade students who attend a public school, including Thurston Elementary School, to receive a My Future Fund account with free money to jump start their savings for college and career training.

Here's what you need to know:

- All eligible students will start with a \$25 deposit to start their account, and some students may qualify for an extra \$475 based on their family income.
- Accounts will automatically be created for all eligible students this fall who are not on the district's directory information opt out list
- To take full advantage of the program benefits, families should complete the Release of Information form by October 6, 2023.
- Families who have requested that the district not share their students' directory information must complete the Release of Information form in order for their students to receive an account by October 6, 2023.
- A parent/guardian can claim the extra \$475 for their child if their student is individually eligible for free or reduced price lunch or meet other criteria and gives permission in the Release of Information form for the My Future Fund staff to examine students' eligibility.
- Families who do not wish to participate must complete an opt-out form also due by October 6, 2023.

#### Raise money for Thurston every time you shop!

Start earning money for Thurston Elementary while doing your regular shopping! A few minutes of your time can earn hundreds of dollars at no cost to you. Now is a great time to **sign up for (or renew) your store fundraising accounts!** 

Currently only a small fraction of Thurston families are participating. Please take a few minutes to set up or renew your accounts, and you will earn money for your school every time you shop! To make it easier, we've included step-by-step instructions below:

#### **Busch's**



- 1. To enroll in Cash for Education, you must have a MyWay account. If you are already a Busch's member, log in to your MyWay account through buschs.com/MyWay and find "Cash for Education" under "Community" on the menu.
- 2. Choose Thurston PTO from the list of organizations (for all quarters) and every purchase you make will earn rewards.
- 3. Select up to four organizations that you would like to support for each quarter using the drop down menu. Purchases will be allocated equally between your chosen organizations.
- 4. Participants will be required to re-enroll on an annual basis. You will receive an email reminder before the next year's enrollment begins.
- 5. Just be sure to use your MyWay card or phone number at checkout.
- 6. You must have a valid email address and opt in to receive emails to participate in this program. You can check this information under My Account > Account Holder when logged into MyWay.
- 7. Busch's will sometimes update accounts after one year, so check the Community tab periodically to make sure Thurston is still receiving your rewards.

#### <u>Kroger</u>



- 1. Get a Kroger Plus Card at the customer service desk or use the one you already have.
- 2. To start earning Kroger's Community Rewards program, you need to create an account at kroger.com. Go to Create an Account and type in your name and Kroger Plus card number. If you already have a digital account, please ensure you have a Plus Card linked to your account.
- 3. Click on My Account and scroll to the bottom where it says Community Rewards
- 4. Click Enroll and fill out the required information
- 5. You will now be able to search for and select the organization you want to link your card with. Search for Thurston PTO (organization number VY999) and click Enroll.
- 6. Scan your Kroger Plus card whenever you check out. Kroger often offers special discounts to cardholders in addition to the community rewards program.

Note: Kroger requires everyone to re-enroll after April 30th!
