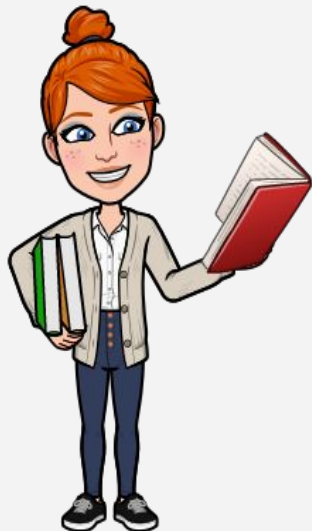

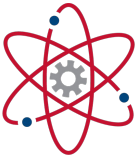

- Call and response

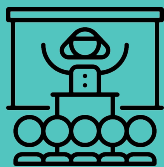
## 4th/5th Grade
