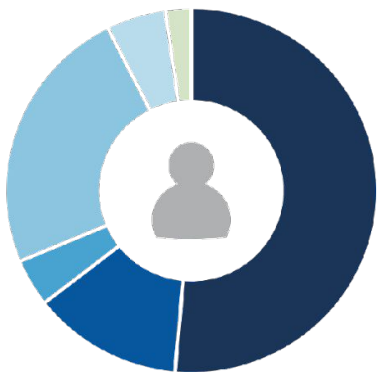

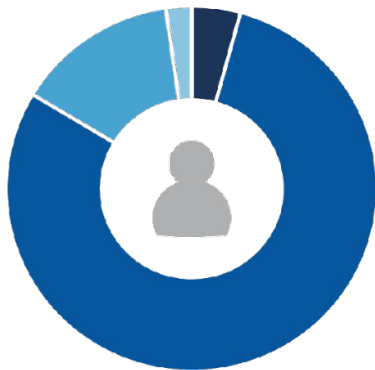

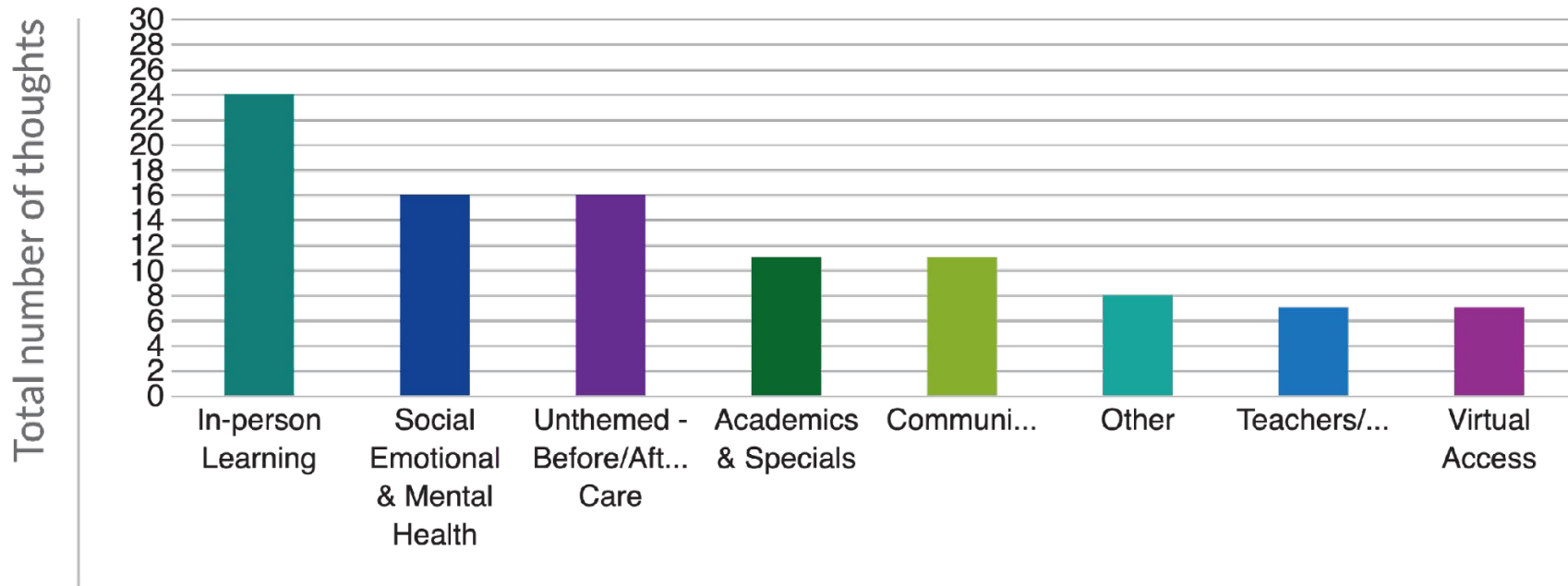
Since there is no before and aftercare, AAPS needs to announce the start and end times of school NOW. 4.3 ★ ★ ★ ★ ☆ (49 👤)
