Logan PTSO Meeting Minutes

Principal Report: Will Wright

- 1) Families interested in A2 Virtual are able to do so at the marking period. Now is your time.You may have new kids in class after Thanksgiving.
- 2) Vaccines for students are now available! We have at least one student vaccinated. With the availability of vaccines, there is one change. The guidance for fully vaccinated students is that there is no required quarantine. Testing 3-5 days. Hoping that after winter break we will need to quarantine less students.
- 3) Report cards going out after Winter Break. Going out digitally unless your child has an IEP. Those reports are on paper.
- 4) We have a new PE teacher. He goes by Coach. He's a 30 yr veteran teacher and he's doing great. Moved to A2 to be closer to family. It's great news!

President's Report: Kerri Randall

- Literacy Budget: Has traditionally gone to the book room. Book room is coming to a close, so we are going to form a literacy committee. We need a PTSO volunteer to sit on this committee that helps determine where the money is spent. There's \$3530 carryover funding on the line item right now. Perhaps Aron wants to sit on the committee as treasurer? Laura Emmer is volunteering to sit on the committee - a great choice! Still need an Upper EL representative.
- 2) Outdoor Space Fundraising: Where are we directing these efforts? Rosi, Carlos, Becky and Will have discussed. On the list:
 - Shed/Storage Space on the Upper EL playground with recess supplies with a padlock to keep it secure.
 - Discussion regarding a similar space on the Lower EL playground or book shelves in book room. Alternatively, outdoor.
 - How much funding is available? \$1700 directed funds
 - We need a foundation (poured concrete or gravel). A rubbermaid shed or a wood structure.
 - Rosi is looking at prices.
 - Benches for upper EL. Eating spaces is another consideration.
 - Requirements include 30 feet from building and distance from property line.
 - If we have volunteers, we can save on labor.

- Goal: Getting information together and then having it ready for the spring? If we are pouring concrete, we need to wait for it to warm up. We should shoot to have it done this year. We can also review fundraising if needed.
- Sean Smith or Bernie Rice are Facilities contacts.
- Next steps: Determine what we want, pricing and getting it done this year.
- Article for the Logan Ledger here is the plan and how to volunteer to update outdoor space.
- Sign Coordination Karen Chou Request to replace file folders and letters for the sign. Less than \$100. Affordable and the box needs replacing. Spend from balance as long as we have a healthy balance. Approved.
- 4) Sonali Request for Logan Ledger. Teacher interview response has been very low. PTSO members are encouraged to sign up their children. How to increase participation? Any other ideas? Perhaps we can offer an incentive. Families and staff are feeling pretty stretched and it can be hard to recruit extras. We need to publish it and put it out there. A recorded Zoom interview can be linked to the newsletter. Kerri to share feedback.
- 5) Events Anything else we can do as a PTSO? Outdoor events or academic enrichment? PTSO sponsored skating night. Something to encourage community. Does not seem like we will be able to have everyone indoor somewhere. Sledding hill/ Huron Hills for a sledding meetup (by the golf course). We have the funds to get everyone together in a safe way. Let us know your ideas!

VP of Communication Report: Kerri Randall (Sharing for Sonali)

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Treasurer Report: Aron

- Latest report was shared via email. Starting Balance of \$36,827.46 \$1800.00 in income in October Still waiting to transfer funds (\$5200.00) in Paypal Sponsorship from Brust for Balloon arch Teacher Vouchers (\$2800.00 - ¼ of funding so far utilized) Grants (\$3100.00)
- 2) Grant BrainPop this is a recurring subscription and Aron discussed it with them. People are utilizing BrainPop so not cancelling yet. Can we see who is using BrainPop? Library is utilizing it. It's an add-on and not attached to the curriculum. Does PTSO want to continue sponsoring it? Will will survey the staff to determine who is using it.

3) Transition from TCF to Huntington in mid-October. We have new account numbers, log-ins, etc. Aron would like to order new checks. Costco has the best deal (about 20 cents for security checks vs. 8 cents for a regular check). We write about 100 checks/year for reimbursements. Difference between regular and secure checks is difficulty to copy/more secure. Standard checks are currently used and consensus is that those are ok moving forward. (Expected cost of \$45 for 600 checks and \$30 for a binder to organize.)

Huntington is a participant in Zelle so we can consider virtual payments.

4) Consider getting an Amazon Business account (tax-exempt; \$179 cost/year). Signed up for a trial basis to see what they may want to charge us. Two big advantages are the sales tax exemption and that the account with all the purchase history would be transferable to the next treasurer. Great idea! Makes sense moving forward.
