In Library class, we have spent time focusing on the importance of having a healthy media balance, encouraging students to look for opportunities where they can take breaks from their devices. We brainstormed activities that are fun to do individually, with friends, and as a family that are device-free.

Y5-K students learned how to regulate their emotions when asked to transition from an online activity to an offline one with the [Pause, Breathe, and Finish Up](#) strategy,

1st-2nd graders had the opportunity to sing along to the [Balance is Important](#) song,

and

3rd-5th graders have been encouraged to thoughtfully consider what their [media balance](#) looks like.

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The kids learned about the coming-of-age tradition of the quinceañera, a celebration of a girl's fifteenth birthday. Using the comprehensible input strategy of TPRS (teaching proficiency through reading and storytelling), students acted out a quinceañera, including the symbolic gestures of the last doll (la muñeca), the crown (la corona), and the first pair of high heels (los tacones).

They also sampled Mexican hot chocolate, which is typically enjoyed during Día de los Muertos and Las Posadas. It is quite different from the hot chocolate they are used to, as it contains canela (cinnamon).
