- Update from Meg & Alison
 - Funky COVID year. Still figuring out what events we can do.
 - Virtual expo, Dec 9 (Thurs). Evening. Live speakers plus website with virtual portfolio.
 - Winter Arts market, date TBD
 - THANK YOU for the tent (donated, plus continual donations for picnic tables). Kids might be able to eat outside all winter.
 - Hired two more Teaching Assistants. Starting later this month (significant onboarding).
 - Will be hiring new middle school English/ELA or a year-long sub. (Know anyone?)
 - Fire alarms: quite a few unexpected in addition to drills. Smoke alarms (3 extra) / cause is known and parts are on order.
 - Parent-teacher conferences are specific to teachers. Read teachers' correspondence for Google Form/ signup genius. Taking place throughout the month.
 - Last week of the month, "spirit week" with themes each day
 - A2Steam, no Halloween costume parade (no Halloween). Friday will be pajama day (or maybe funny hat/hair day). Details will be in newsletter
 - Oct 20, Wed, early release
 - Oct 29, Fri, half day (dismissal at 10:47am) [two the entire year]. Lunch will be served, grab & go

- Treasurer report Candace
 - Books are now up to date through Sept 30, 2021. (CONGRATS!).
 - Blg \$ but some of this is pass-through funds. (\$ we're holding for various groups, eq the solar fund is \$25K)
 - Exceeded our goal for Fall dues! Almost 1,000\$ over, which takes pressure off for rest of year <fundraising>.
 - Ad hoc picnic table fundraiser going well, in just a few hours at \$910. Just doing some shopping online, figuring out what's approved. (Note-- this also means, Meg, your emails are being read!)
 - We had several events this fall that came in under budget or didn't happen (\$1200 budgeted for things and now it's floating out there;
 - Candace moves that we transfer \$700 (originally \$1200) into a COVID fund to be used at admin discretion, including things like emergency buy picnic tables, heater thing for tents?, equipment that went home to families, licenses for reading A-Z, for hay bales/sit upons)
 - i. Save some of the \$ for an in-person thing in spring?
 - ii. Or an online Fall thing?
 - iii. Bring it up at this meeting (done!) and now we'll vote at the next one
 - Q re: pass through accounts, email Candace
